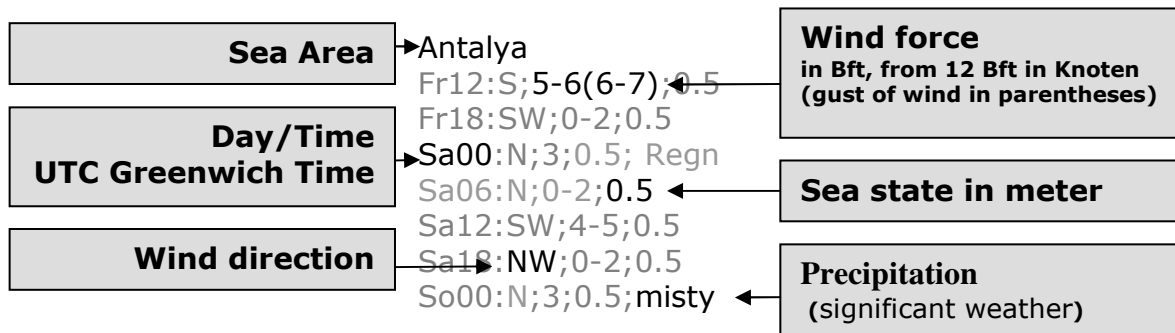


What does the forecast look like?

When will the reports be sent?

Reports will automatically be sent at 9:30 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. Central European Time.

If I live in a different time zone, will the report times be adjusted?

No. All information will be listed in Greenwich Mean Time.

How often is the weather data updated?

At the time the message is automatically sent (see above).

How can I check marine weather reports for other sailing areas?

Generally, you have the option of ordering additional automatic marine weather reports per text message. Simply reply to the sender of the automatic message's number with a text message containing the corresponding code (e.g. 21).

What should I do if I change my sailing plan?

With us, you'll not only receive the marine weather reports you've orders, but can also request sea weather reports for other areas (see above). If you'd like to automatically receive marine weather reports for the new cruise plan, please call us at (05204) 880375 and inform us of your new plans. We will then immediately change your order. If you are unable to reach us personally, please leave your change request on our answering machine.

What do the abbreviations mean?

The four directions:

N (North), E (East), S (South) and W (West)
